Glassbead Blast Cleaning for a Micro Smooth Finish

Glassbead blasting helps eliminate welding and grinding marks on stainless steel, aluminum and fabricated parts. Leaves surface with a uniformed matte finish. A great way to save time and money.

Our two large, enclosed rooms approximately 12' x 12' with recirculating glass beads can handle most sizes of aluminum or stainless steel parts.
